What is online storage?

A website where you can store files of any size or type, typically free of charge.

A storage system that you can access on-the-go on nearly any mobile device.

A secure method of storage for your files.

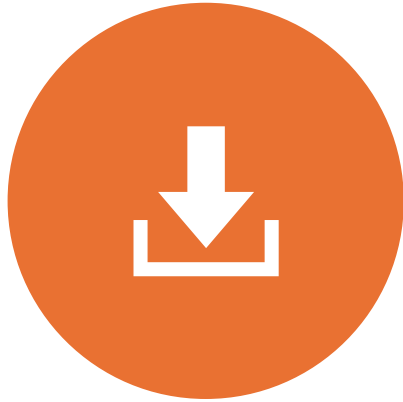
(OneDrive, Mac Time Machine)
Something where you can back up files on your computer.



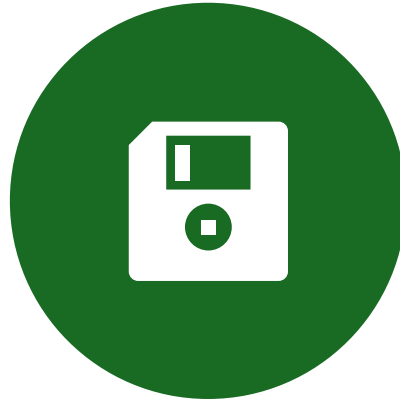
Examples of Online Storage Systems

- Comes, by default, with any Windows computer or Microsoft Account.
- Offers backups of your Windows PC so that, if you get a new computer, you can retain the files you had on the original one.
- OneDrive offers a free 5 gigabytes of storage. Outlook Email storage does not count towards this limit.



Is not associated with any online account (ie. Google or Microsoft) that you may have previously created.



Has more advanced features for document sharing and collaboration



Has a desktop app which can be integrated with File Explorer



Easier-to-use version: DropBox – Box itself is primarily used for Enterprise, however, it can be used as a good alternative to Google Drive or OneDrive.



Comes, by default, with 10 gigabytes of storage
