- Free Music and Radio
- Unlimited Skipping of Songs
- Personalized Stations/Playlists
- Offline Access – Access anytime, anywhere



Pros of using Amazon Music

- Free version includes millions of podcasts and songs
- If you have Amazon Prime, you get ad-free music, for free!
- Unlimited Skipping of Songs
- Ability to make Playlists
- Amazon Music Unlimited for \$10/month or \$100/year
- Offline Access – Access anytime, anywhere
- Comes pre-installed on Amazon Alexa.



Pros of using Apple Music

- No ads
- Pre-Installed on iPhones
- Works with Apple CarPlay
- Downloadable Application for Computers
- Pre-Installed on Mac computers.




